### ADVOCACY



ABC's public policy priorities guide our advocacy efforts and include supporting sustained funding increases for NIH, including the BRAIN Initiative, NSF, and the Department of Veterans Affairs; expanding access to chronic care; laws and regulations that ensure the humane treatment and safety of animals in research; the implementation and enforcement of Mental Health Parity; and innovative approaches for developing new CNS cures.
